Code of Conduct — Coaches & Poolside Volunteers

Purpose:

To set out the professional standards expected of all coaches, teachers, and poolside volunteers representing KCMC.

As a coach or volunteer, I will:

- 1. Act professionally and be a positive role model in behaviour, language, and attitude.
- 2. Prioritise swimmer welfare, safety, and enjoyment above all else.
- 3. Treat all swimmers equally, with respect and without discrimination or favouritism.
- 4. Maintain appropriate boundaries avoid physical contact except when necessary and with consent.
- 5. Promote inclusivity and adapt training where appropriate for ability, health, or personal needs.
- 6. Keep confidentiality share information about swimmers only when necessary and in line with safeguarding or club policy.
- 7. Engage in continued learning maintain relevant Swim England qualifications and stay up to date with best practice.
- 8. Communicate clearly provide constructive feedback and foster a supportive training environment.
- 9. Report concerns immediately raise any welfare, safety, or conduct concerns to the Club Welfare Officer or Chairperson.
- 10. Uphold Swim England values abide by Wavepower, Code of Ethics, and the club's policies at all times.
